Phase 1

5,000 Trees in Ramtek District, Maharashtra in partnership with Grow-Trees

Sabre has committed to plant the first 5000 Trees in the Ramtek district, Maharashtra, India within 3 months (this monsoon cycle). **The plantation of indigenous species like Drumsticks, Custard Apple, Neem, Amla, Shisham, Jamun, etc.** in this region of the state will not only benefit the environment, and the wildlife but also the rural communities by adding an additional stream of revenue to their income.



Grow-Trees, our planting partner (India based social enterprise) has planted over 17 million trees in 23 states in India since its inception in 2010.

Grow-Trees will adopt the 1+3 plantation strategy in adverse conditions, planting one main sapling alongside three local species seeds suited to the ecological conditions.

Benefits

Rural Communities

Tribal population comprises almost 96% of the total population in the Ramtek district, Maharashtra, who heavily depend on the forest-based industry for their livelihoods.

The project aims to discourage villagers from engaging in illegal activities such as poaching by developing a dense buffer zone through the plantation of indigenous species

Employment Generation

400+ workdays for the labour force of which more than 70% are women

CO₂ Absorption Capacity

Each tree can **absorb at least 20kg of CO₂ per year** upon maturity (seed bearing age)
